ReCap ASáp: Regaining capacity in a changing Sápmi

The end of the first full year of the ReCap ASáp project is coming to its end, and it has been an eventful year and autumn!

The Advocacy Program

The biggest change this autumn is that the project has expanded with 5 new employees! We have hired three talented participants to our Advocacy program, and two mentors who are following them. The participants are Janne Hirvasvuopio (FIN), Izabel Nordlund (SWE), and Per-Henning Mathisen (NOR). Petra Laiti and Rune Fjellheim are hired as their mentors. In the few months they have been in the programme, they have already helped with and participated in a wide variety of activities.

They have had two gatherings where they have all been together. We kicked off the Advocacy Program in Giron in September, where the participants got to meet the rest of the ReCap ASáp team, and get to know each other. There they also got to meet with institutions and organisations based in Giron, such as the Sámi Parliament in Sweden, Giron Sámesearvi, and Giron Sámi Teáhter.

Representatives from Gabna and Talma čearut also gave an introduction to the issues affecting them, such as the mining industry surrounding Giron, and the Estrate Space Center.

In December they met in Kárášjohka. There they visited the Sámi Parliament in Norway and NRK Sápmi. They also went to Anár, to get to know the Sámi Parliament in Finland.

In addition to working with the Saami Council's units, the participants have participated in multiple other activities. Izabel participated in CBD COP 16 in Cali, Colombia, and Per-Henning and Janne in COP29 in Baku, Azerbaijan, where they learned about how the Saami Council works with international processes. They have also helped arrange events. Per-Henning helped with the 2nd International Gathering of Indigenous Salmon Peoples, and Izabel helped during KulturSápmi2024. They have also participated in research conferences, such as the 6th Nordic Conference for Rural Research, and Insight and outlook - Conference on Sábmie related research.

What's happened this autumn

The ReCap ASáp team has continued the tour of the Saami Council member organisations' annual meetings. In September, Helene visited Sámiid Álbmotlihttus (SFF) meeting in Romsa. Åsa and Enni attended Norgga Sámiid Riikkasearvis (NSR) meeting in Leavdnja in November. These have been good opportunities to present the project and the possibilities to participate in project activities, and to forge closer bonds with the member organisations.

The Sámi Leadership Network has had their first meeting in Áлта this autumn. They are looking forward to continuing developing this network.

The work in the Knowledge hubs are also continuing, and multiple meetings have been held this autumn. Next year will be spent arranging the last meetings, and start working on the results which will be ready by the Saami Conference in 2026.

In this period, the project team has also attended two webinars hosted by Interreg Aurora. In the beginning of October, we were invited to speak about our work with the Social Development Goals. In November, we followed a webinar on communication in projects.
